



COMMUNITY LEGAL INTERMEDIARY TRAINING COURSE

Fall 2014 - SESSION #36

The Community Legal Intermediary Training Course (CLI) is a program that targets individuals who are often called upon to help others in the community with legal problems, whether in the role of a worker, friend or community leader. The program provides participants with basic knowledge about our laws and legal system, and informs them about the proper role of a legal intermediary. The CLI program is sponsored by Community Legal Education Association (CLEA), a not-for-profit community agency that provides Manitobans with a variety of public legal education services. The program is presented with the help of many talented and dedicated lawyers and volunteers. Classes for the 36th Session of the CLI program will start on Tuesday, September 23, 2014 and continue each Tuesday until December 2nd (except for Remembrance Day – November 11th). Classes run from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm at Suite 205 – 414 Graham Avenue, Winnipeg. The total length of the course is 10 weeks. The cost of the course is \$100.00. Register early, as space is limited to 10 participants.
